SCHOLARSHIP: WRVCLF will award three scholarships to eligible applicants.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- 1) Be a United States citizen from the West River Veterinary Clinic trade area (Southwest ND and Northwest SD).
- 2) Be a graduating high school senior.
- 3) Be planning to attend a 2 to 4 year post-secondary, accredited undergraduate degree program or a technical/vocational school with a major in the veterinary, microbiological, agricultural, medical, or animal sciences.
- 4) Must present letter of acceptance from the college/technical/vocational school.
- 5) Funds will be dispersed following the first semester after having received a current transcript of grades from the college/university where student is presently enrolled.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) A completed West River Veterinary Clinic Legacy Foundation Scholarship Application form (no substitute forms) including:
 - a. Copy of your official transcript and copy of your current ACT/SAT score(s).
 - b. Listing of volunteer work/job experiences.
 - c. Listing of extracurricular activities/organizations.
 - d. Listing of accomplishments, honors, and awards received.
- 2) A written recommendation/character reference letter for the applicant must accompany the application. Such letter may be from a teacher, counselor, community leader, religious leader, or work supervisor.
- 3) An essay, between 300-400 words on the subject of **“How, through your involvement in community/school activities, 4-H, FFA, or work and volunteer efforts, have you promoted the advancement of veterinary medicine, agriculture, or animal health?”**

JUDGING CRITERIA:

The Judging Committee shall consist of current board members of the WR Veterinary Clinic Legacy Foundation, and will score each requirement on the following categories:

- 1) Academic
- 2) Volunteer and work experience
- 3) Extracurricular activities/organization
- 4) Accomplishments, honors, and awards
- 5) Essay
- 6) Overall appearance, content, grammar, and neatness of application

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications must be postmarked by **April 1, 2019** and sent to the address listed on the cover page, to the ATTN: Dr. Ethan Andress
